

Overview

It's well known that innovation is a product of an organizational culture that makes collaboration a priority. The leadership at Oatey, a family-owned, global manufacturer of quality plumbing products, understands this well. In business for more than 100 years, Oatey was ready for a new corporate headquarters that enables communication and nurtures its collaborative culture to increase innovation.

Oatey staff were spread across three campuses that physically disconnected people, impeded technology and movement, created silos, and required people to walk or drive from different locations. Company leadership desired a space that would improve adjacencies to foster collaboration and drive innovation. The new building would also incorporate sustainability goals and employee well-being in an open, transparent environment. And it would be designed to effectively adapt to the ever-evolving ways people work.

Objective

Consolidate staff from separate facilities into one campus with an open environment to foster stronger partnerships across the organization.

Solution

Design a headquarters with an open floorplan that promotes collaboration, communication, and transparency throughout the organization.

Results

A state-of-the-art, sustainable, and energyefficient space designed to enhance collaboration and communication.

Taking Oatey to the Next Level

Oatey company leadership desired a space that would improve adjacencies to foster collaboration and drive innovation. - 1 Workplace Visibility
 The design team was deliberate about using glass doors on conference rooms and lowerheight workstations to maintain visibility among coworkers.
- 2 Sustainable Features
 The material palettes—including earthy, warm elements—connect with the building's natural setting to reinforce sustainability principles in a contemporary design.
- 3 Nature for Enhanced Well-Being With the natural beauty of the Metroparks—an extensive system of nature preserves—in its back yard, Oatey's headquarters offers employees access to daylight, views of the park, and connection to nature—which is important to foster well-being at work.
- 4 Space for Connecting
 Multiple indoor cafés and casual
 meeting spaces with ancillary
 furniture were created to bring
 people together.


From the moment you walk in the lobby to see the goals and objectives listed on the wall, there is a visual connection to the site and environment that clearly aligns with who and what Oatey is.

Open Floorplan

An open floorplan was designed to promote collaboration, communication, and transparency, with people adjacent to each other.





Wood Accents

Additional Amenities

A fitness suite, a quarter-mile outdoor walking path, a picnic area, and indoor/outdoor cafés provide areas for staff to unwind, rest, and re-center themselves throughout the workday.




A Flexible Space That Adapts for the Future

Flexibility and Comfort
